## What is this product?

### TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a Sub-Fund of Quaero Capital Funds (Lux), an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

### TERM

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However if, for any reason, the net assets of the Sub-Fund or of any Class or Sub-Class fall below the equivalent of EUR 5,000,000, or if a change in the economic or political environment of the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class may have material adverse consequences on the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class's investments, or if an economic rationalisation so requires, the board may decide on a compulsory redemption of all Shares outstanding in the Sub-Fund, Class or Sub-Class on the basis of the Net Asset Value per Share (after taking account of current realisation prices of the investments as well as realisation expenses), calculated as of the day the decision becomes effective.

### OBJECTIVES

#### Objectives and investment policy

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve superior absolute returns as well as superior risk-adjusted returns.

The Sub-Fund will mainly invest in, but not limited to, equities.

It will also invest in depositary receipts (American Depositary Receipt) (ADR), International Depositary Receipt) (IDR) and Global Depositary Receipts (GDR)) for the purpose of gaining indirect exposure to equity and/or equity related securities.

The Sub-Fund may also invest, on an ancillary basis, in money market instruments, financial derivative instruments, bank deposits, undertakings for collective investment (UCIs), debt instruments and in other eligible investments.

However, the Sub-Fund will invest:

- in sovereign, supranational and corporate bond with a rating of not less than BB by Standard & Poor's, or its equivalent by Moody's or another rating agency. Investments in bonds are only anticipated to be made in circumstances when equity markets are not performing and in the best interests of the Sub-Fund.
  - up to 10% of its net assets in UCIs,
  - up to 25% of its net assets in emerging markets
- The Sub-Fund will not invest in contingent convertible bonds.

The equity asset class exposure should represent between 30% and 125% of the Sub-Fund's net assets.

However, under exceptional market circumstances, the Sub-Fund's exposure to equities may fall below 30% and the Sub-Fund's exposure to cash and cash equivalents assets may exceed 40%.

**Derivatives** The Sub-Fund is authorised to invest in financial derivative instruments for currency hedging and/or for investment purposes.

**Benchmark** The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Sub-Fund uses the index MSCI World Hedged Net Total Return USD for performance comparison only. The Sub-Fund does not track the index and can deviate significantly or entirely from the index.

**Dividend Policy** This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

**Share Class Currency** The currency of the Class is USD.

The recommended holding period of this product is determined to allow sufficient time for this product to reach its objectives and avoiding short term market fluctuations.

The return of the product is determined using the Net Asset Value (the "NAV") calculated by the Central administration. This return depends mainly on the market value fluctuations of the underlying investments.

### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is reserved to financial intermediaries and certain platforms that have been approved by the Global Distributor/Investment Manager and that have fee arrangements with their clients which are based on accepting and keeping fees or commissions and retail investors. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

### OTHER INFORMATION

**Depositary** Pictet & Cie (Europe) S.A. (the "Depositary").

**Asset segregation** The assets and liabilities of each sub-fund are segregated by law, which means that the performance of the assets in other sub-funds does not influence the performance of your investment.

**Dealing** The Net Asset Value for the Class is calculated on each business day ("the Valuation Day"). The cut-off time to submit subscription orders is 4 p.m., one business day before the relevant Valuation Day. The cut-off time to submit redemption orders is 4 p.m., one business day before the relevant Valuation Day.

**Switching** Shareholders may apply for any share of any sub-funds to be converted into shares of another sub-fund, provided that the conditions for accessing the target class are fulfilled with respect to this Sub-Fund, on the basis of their respective Net Asset Value calculated on the Valuation Day following receipt of the conversion request. The redemption and subscription costs connected with the conversion may be charged to the shareholder as indicated in the prospectus. ## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

### Performance scenarios

## What happens if FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company is not making any payment to you in relation to this Sub-Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from the Management Company.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with a separate company, the Depositary, so the Sub-Fund's ability to pay out would not be affected by the insolvency of the Management Company. However, in the event of the Depositary's insolvency, or its delegates, the Sub-Fund may suffer a financial loss. However, this risk is mitigated to a certain extent by the fact the Depositary is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the Sub-Fund. The Depositary will also be liable to the Sub-Fund or its investors for any loss arising from, among other things, its negligence, fraud or intentional failure properly to fulfill its obligations (subject to certain limitations).

If the Sub-Fund is terminated or wound up, the assets will be liquidated and you will receive an appropriate share of any proceeds but you may lose part or all of your investment.

There is no compensation or guarantee scheme protecting you from a default of the Depositary.

## What are the costs?

## Costs over time
