## What is this product?

### TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a Sub-Fund of Prosperity Capital Management Sicav, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a variable capital investment company (SICAV) under the laws of Luxembourg.

### TERM

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However if the net assets of the Sub Fund or a Class fall below the equivalent of 10 million euros or if, in the opinion of the board, significant changes in the political or economic situation render this decision necessary, in order to proceed to an economic rationalisation or if the interests of the shareholders of the Sub Fund or a Class of shares so require, the board may decide on a forced redemption of the remaining shares in the Sub Fund or Class of shares concerned without any approval of the shareholders being necessary.

### OBJECTIVES

The investment objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve capital growth over the long term.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Sub-Fund has no benchmark and is not managed in reference to a benchmark index.

The Sub-Fund's assets will principally be invested in equities and related instruments (such as convertibles, options, subscription rights and certificates of deposit and warrants) in the markets of Russia and former Soviet Union countries (such as Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Belarus, Uzbekistan, Azerbaijan, Turkmenistan, Georgia, Armenia, Moldova, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan) and in companies that are listed in OECD countries and for which Russia is a key market.

The Sub-Fund will only use financial derivative instruments and techniques for hedging purposes.

This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

### INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is reserved for professional investors. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 5 years.

## What happens if FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is unable to pay out?

FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is not making any payment to you in relation to this Sub-Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A..

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with Pictet & Cie (Europe) S.A. and are segregated from the assets of other Sub-Funds of the Fund. The assets of the Sub-Fund cannot be used to pay the debts of other Sub-Funds.

## What are the costs?

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. ## How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

### Recommended holding period (RHP): 5 years.

The RHP was chosen to provide a consistent return less dependent on market fluctuations.

A redemption order is executed at the redemption price ruling on a Business Day (a full business day on which banks are fully open in Luxembourg), the application for the redemption of shares must reach the Administration Agent (FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A.) before 11:00 a.m. (Luxembourg time) on the Business Day preceding the relevant Business Day.
